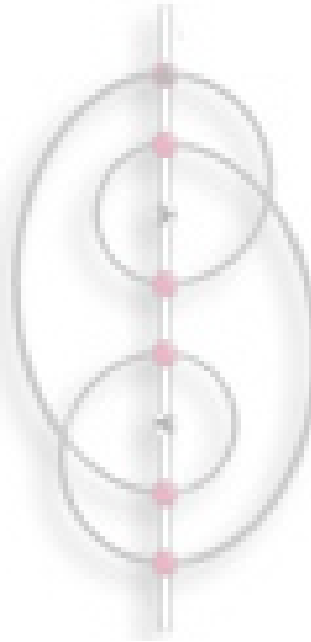


If...

you have already seen

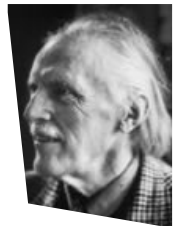
- that the human and natural worlds are increasingly in serious trouble, but that large scale governments and institutions are unable to identify the real problems or enact real solutions;

The Course

We have called this course an “Intensive” because you will immediately test, verify, and apply almost everything you learn here. It will be an intense immersion in self-observation and practical self-discovery.

This residential program is situated on a forested fifty-acre property in central Massachusetts. The course runs seven days a week, twenty-four hours a day, with occasional days off. Students typically have two days of study and then one day of cooking, cleaning, gardening, construction,

and other practical activities to maintain the operations of the school. These “house” days are integral to the learning process, as the inner work continues and even intensifies during the activities of ordinary daily life.

A typical day starts with a morning sitting where Gurdjieff’s inner spiritual exercises are taught. After breakfast, those not on house duty attend classes in Gurdjieff’s Movements (sacred dance), psychology, cosmology, energies, art, and music. During the evening there may be meditations, discussions, or other creative activities.
